

## Electrotechnology Testing Summary of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Accreditation Advisory Committee Meeting

The second meeting of the Electrotechnology Testing (ETT) Accreditation Advisory Committee was held by Zoom on 13th May 2021.

### Review of current membership and composition

The Committee discussed breadth of testing covered by the current membership and future requirements for additional expertise. The Committee recognised the need for expertise in the gaming industry and after several unsuccessful expressions of interest agreed to directly approach the various State Government regulators for potential candidates.

### Review of relevant Accreditation Criteria

The Criteria and Guidance documents applicable to ETT are in the process of being reviewed by AAC members.

### Review of Scope of Accreditation Descriptors

The Committee noted that a review of the current Service descriptors will be undertaken once the review of the Criteria and Guidance documents has been finalised.

### Changes to Standards, Specifications, Regulatory Bodies, etc.

The committee were provided with an update on the changes to the Gambling Commission of Great Britain's test house framework. The Gambling Commission has introduced new requirements for facilities who conduct testing on gaming machine software, which will have significant implications on providers of gaming software/hardware and how NATA accredits these facilities.

### Assessors

The Committee discussed Technical Assessor usage, identification of disciplines requiring recruitment, new appointments, retirements, training programs and needs.

The next meeting is planned for early 2022.
