Opening & welcome	Welcome and introductory remarks from the Chair
Committee Member & Reports	Phillips on-going recalls was discussed. Facilities are expected to comply with the advice issued by the TGA in relation to the recall.  Introduction of new technologies. Facilities must ensure that equipment is listed on the ARTG as a medical device and must indicate that the equipment is suitable for use.
Stakeholder engagement	It was noted that there is potential to interact more with the private health insurers.  NATA had a presentation and a booth at this years Sleep DownUnder conference. This was a great opportunity to raise NATA's profile and interact with many of our stakeholders.
New ISO 15189	The International Standard ISO 15189 has been reviewed. This is the Standard on which the ASA Standard has been based. The ASA will look at whether the new ISO format will be adopted.
Next meeting	The next meeting is planned for November 2023.
