Committee Membership

- Messers David Evans and Thomas Kovacs joined the committee since the last meeting.
- Mr Tony Sweetland retired from the committee.
- Mr Ian Stewart passed away in February 2022.
- Expressions of interest will be sought for someone with expertise in geotextiles.

Reports from Members

- There was discussion concerning the staffing challenges that laboratories face nationally and the difficulties of finding suitably qualified supervisory staff.
- Sustainability and use of recycled materials in road construction
- Difficulty with the assessment of sampling activities
- Lack of preparedness of laboratories for accreditation assessment visits.
- Challenges acquiring reference stone for facilities performing polished aggregate friction value tests were discussed.

Stakeholder Engagement

- MOUs with QTMR, TfNSW and DoT have been resigned.
- A new MOU with MRWA has been established.
- NATA continues to engage with industry bodies, regulators and specifiers.

Service Descriptors

Service descriptors described in the NATA publication Specific Accreditation

asset integrity are generally considered suitable and fit for purpose.

Miscellaneous Discussion

 A risk-based model for assessing annex facilities was discussed by the Committee. A draft of the risk assessment tool was discussed, and further improvements were suggested.
