Stakeholder engagement	The TGA and The Commonwealth Department of Health and Aged Care provided an update on activities and future directions.
Discussion	Workforce shortages. A discussion was held on the increasing concerns with pathology workforce shortages which are beginning to have a detrimental affect on some facilities ability to comply with the assessment criteria.
