SUMMARY OF 24 MAY MEETING

- **Members' Representatives Group**

NATA's intention to seek expression of interest for vacant positions and positions which would become vacant after October 2018 was tabled.

- **Review of issues from last meeting of the Members' Representatives - General Discussion - Oct 2017**

There was no further discussion held regarding any specific Member feedback.

- **ISO/IEC 17025 Transition Plan**

An updated was provided on NATA's intended approach to assessing facilities to the 2017 version of the Standard.

- **ISO/IEC 17011 Implementation**

The Standard (to which NATA as an accreditation body must comply) was issued in late 2017. NATA will be evaluated against the new Standard early in 2019. A summary of the changes as affecting NATA and Members was provided.

- **Survey outcomes**

Members' Representatives were provided with data in relation to NATA's current survey activities.

- **AIMS Subproject III**

An update on NATA's intended approach to this subproject, including the development of a new Portal was presented.

- **UTS Report on Economic Value of NATA Accreditation**

The outcomes from the survey commissioned by NATA were presented.

- **ILAC Laboratory Committee (LC)**

NATA Board Chair Geoff Hogg provided an update from discussions held at the last meeting of the LC.
