Purpose

This document describes the NATA DIAS logo which is available for use by practices accredited by NATA under the Diagnostic Imaging Accreditation Scheme (DIAS).

The conditions for the use of the NATA emblem are detailed in the *General* Accreditation Criteria: Use of the NATA emblem, NATA endorsement and references to accreditation available from the NATA website.

The NATA emblem (as defined in Schedule 1 of the *NATA Rules*) is not to be used by Diagnostic Imaging practices accredited under DIAS.

The NATA DIAS logo

The NATA logo available for use by practices accredited under DIAS consists of the NATA emblem, accompanied by the following mandatory statement:

Accredited under the Diagnostic Imaging Accreditation Scheme

The NATA emblem and mandatory statement have been combined in a single image to form the NATA DIAS logo which is available from the NATA website here.

The printing colours of the logo must be reproduced as follows:
